Dear Colonel Barber

This is in response to your February 21, 2001 letter requesting reconsideration of your application for correction of military records, AFBCMR Docket Number 91-02347.

We have examined your request and, inasmuch as you have provided no new relevant evidence, we determined it does not meet the criteria for reconsideration by the Board. Reconsideration is authorized only where newly discovered relevant evidence is presented which was not available when the application was submitted. The reiteration of facts previously addressed by the Board, uncorroborated personal observations, or additional arguments on the evidence of record are not adequate grounds for reopening a case.

Therefore, unless you provide new relevant evidence, which meets the criteria for reconsideration, further correspondence along the lines currently being pursued will be filed without action. We regret this, but repeated use of staff resources on issues that have already been decided serves no useful purpose and unnecessarily and unfairly diminishes our ability to address the concerns of other applicants.
