

Dear Colonel Barber

This is in response to your March 6, 2000 letter requesting a 30-day extension of the period to submit a response to the Air Force evaluation of your request for reconsideration of your application for correction of military records, AFBCMR Docket Number 91-02347.

Your request for an additional extension of time in which to submit your response, up to and including April 14, 2000, is granted. However, since it is the desire of the Secretary of the Air Force to process all cases as expeditiously as the workload of this office will permit, additional requests for extensions of time for filing your response to the advisory opinion will not be honored. Therefore, if you cannot respond by the date indicated above, it is suggested that your request for reconsideration of your application be withdrawn without prejudice and without further action by the Air Force Board for Correction of Military Records. Otherwise, I have no recourse except to process your request to the Board, in its turn, for a determination of whether it meets the criteria for reconsideration, and, if so, a further decision as to the relevancy and weight of the newly submitted material.
