Upon motion duly made and seconded, it was unanimously:

Resolved by the General Staff of the Confederate Air Force, that while some aspects of the Yamamoto Mission will forever remain obscured by the fog of war, recent, credible research indicates that Rex T. Barber was the pilot responsible for bringing down the Mitsubishi Betty Bomber carrying Admiral Isoroku Yamamoto, Commander in Chief of the Combined Fleet of the Imperial Japanese Navy. Accordingly, the General Staff of the Confederate Air Force joins the American Fighter Aces Association in recognizing Rex T. Barber as entitled to sole credit for the Yamamoto victory, and recommends that the Office of Air Force History award Col. Barber full credit therefor.
