Here is some of the correspondence between Jimmy Doolittle and Tom Lanphier that I mentioned was in the Doolittle files that are now in the Doolittle Librasry at the Univ. of Texas at Dallas where I am curator.

You will also find a letter from M/G John Condon who disputes John Mitchell's version of who planned the Y mission. General Condon never acknowledged my letter to him asking for an interview or at least an answer giving me his version.

When I was interviewing him for his autobiography, he told me the same thing several times to strengthen the point that he didn't always depend on his memory of events of many years past.
